Reimagining mass urban transport

First Bus is one of the UK's largest bus operators with a fleet of more than 4,500 buses, serving two-thirds of the UK's largest conurbations. Its parent company, FirstGroup, approached us to reimagine the delivery of mass urban transport, with a focus on sustainability and building a clean environment.

After an initial successful deployment of 148 electric buses at First Bus' Caledonia depot in Glasgow, in which we provided managed services for its EV battery assets and EV charging, we agreed to expand our services to cover more than 600 buses across eleven new depots. This was accompanied by a joint cash commitment of £10M to support the acquisition of 1000 batteries.



Deploying ZeroCarbon Fleet

Across all ten depots, we have deployed our ZeroCarbon fleet solution to closely manage each bus' battery health, maintain its optimal performance throughout its contact life, and specify ideal replacement times.

We provide telematics on each bus and electric charging point to share live status information, enabling remote charging and insight into which vehicles are connected to which chargers, and bus charging durations.

ZeroCarbon Fleet also ensures that power is used in the most efficient way, minimizing the draw down from the national grid at peak times, and balancing electricity costs. It ensures that each vehicle is fully charged, and the bus interiors are preheated, ready for drivers and customers from the moment the vehicles leave the depot.

We are also collaborating with First Bus to deliver zero carbon charging hubs at their depots for other business fleet users, enabling the use of EV chargers when they are not in use during the day, delivering new revenue streams for the bus operator.

Together, we are providing world-leading battery charging and management services powered by innovative electric batteries.
